My specialty is mite diversity and evolution, but I am a generalist with broad training in entomology. I enjoy teaching university courses, advising graduate students during their programs, and leading workshops for state agencies, universities, and international organizations. My current projects involve grasshoppers, parasitic mites, and spiders.
