



ANNUAL TIMELINES

Washington County Master Gardeners

This document is a guide for the WCMG President, committees, and members so the organization can operate smoothly from one year to the next.

JANUARY - Beginning of new fiscal year and term of Executive Committee

- 1. Executive Committee is formally installed.
- 2. Membership Committee reviews WCMG membership's hours reports and reports status to the Executive Committee.
- 3. Awards Committee forwards Master Gardener state award nominations (except for local awards) to state MG office prior to January 15th.
- 4. WCMG Member Resource Guide Committee is activated for annual review and revision of documents as needed.
- 5. WCMG New MG in-person Basic Training begins.
- 6. Mentors contact their assigned Trainees and will begin to integrate them into the WCMG program.

FEBRUARY

- 1. WCMG Graduation for Trainees who have completed training requirements and are certified as new WCMG members is held at the monthly WCMG meeting.
- 2. WCMG Awards Program. Award presentations for:
 - a. Master Gardener of the Year
 - b. Rookie of the Year
 - c. Project of the Year
 - d. Friend of Master Gardeners Organization and Individual
 - e. Excellence in Education of the Year
 - f. Mentor of the Year
 - g. Joyce Mendenhall "Yes, I Can" Awards of the Year (local award)
 - h. Trowel Award Recipients 200-plus sanctioned volunteer hours annually (local award)
 - i. Watering Can Award Recipients 200-plus sanctioned hours for 5 consecutive years (local award)
 - j. Wheelbarrow Award Recipients 200-plus sanctioned hours for 10 consecutive years (local award)
 - k. Gold Butterfly Award Recipients 200-plus sanctioned hours for 15 consecutive years (local award)

MARCH

- 1. Annual WCMG Project/Committee Fair takes place during the regular WCMG membership meeting.
- 2. The revised WCMG Member Resource Guide is posted on WCMG website.
- 3. Training Committee will confirm the first ten hours of assigned sanctioned work for new Online Trainees.
- 4. Mentors ensure that Trainees are receiving *Garden Thyme* newsletter, can access the State MG and WCMG website and have subscribed to Constant Contact at **uaex.uada.edu/yard-garden/master-gardeners.**

APRIL

- 1. Executive Committee appoints the Nominations Committee (see July, August, and September).
- 2. Mentors remain engaged with Trainees and explore activities that appeal to Trainees' interests.
- 3. Awards Committee begins presenting WCMG Busy Bee Award pins each month for recording WCMG members and/or Trainees their first 50 sanctioned project/committee hours at WCMG membership meeting.

MAY

- 1. Bylaws, Policies and Procedures Review Committee is activated (Bylaws revisions completed see July.)
- 2. Members and Trainees are reminded to record hours.
- 3. Mentors check with Trainees about recording hours.

JUNE

- 1. Membership meeting and Potluck Picnic at a selected site.
- 2. Master Gardener State Conference in Searcy (White County) is June 5-7, 2025.
- 3. Mentors ensure that Trainees meet people outside their normal circle.
- 4. Membership Committee reviews status of volunteer hours recorded January through May and reports findings to New MG Training/Mentoring Committee and Executive Committee.
- 5. Awards Committee presents WCMG's Years-of-Service pins at the first available WCMG meeting.
- 6. President appoints two WCMG members to serve on Finance Committee with Treasurer.
- 7. Finance Committee requests 2026 budget requests from eligible Sanctioned Project and Committee Chairs.

JULY

- 1. Bylaws, Policies and Procedures Committee presents suggested revisions (if applicable) to Executive Committee for their review and approval.
- 2. Awards Committee begins promotion campaign for WCMG State MG Award nominations.
- 3. Nominations Committee presents officer and members-at-large nominations to Executive Committee for review and approval.

AUGUST

- 1. Washington County Fair takes place the last week of the month.
- 2. Finance Committee reviews the 2026 WCMG budget and makes recommendations to the Executive Committee.
- 3. Slate of WCMG Executive Committee nominees approved by the Executive Committee is announced at the August WCMG meeting and published in the September *Garden Thyme* newsletter.
- 4. Proposed WCMG Bylaws amendments (if applicable) are published in the September *Garden Thyme* newsletter.

SEPTEMBER - ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING

- 1. Election of Executive Committee members.
- 2. Approval of the annual WCMG Budget.
- 3. Approval of WCMG annual dues.
- 4. Approval of Bylaws changes by WCMG membership (if applicable.)
- 5. Approval of membership meeting dates and times for the following year.
- 6. Deadline for State MG online basic training registration.
- 7. WCMG online basic training applicants are interviewed.
- 8. Mentors are assigned Online WCMG Trainees and receive mentoring materials.

OCTOBER

- 1. Annual membership dues collection begins.
- 2. Mentors remind Trainees of December 15th deadline for recording hours.
- 3. Incoming Executive Committee members attend current Executive Committee meetings, formal training begins.
- 4. State MG Online Training begins.
- 5. WCMG in person basic training applicants are interviewed.
- 6. Awards Committee receives all WCMG award nominations by October 15 deadline.
 - a. Master Gardener of the Year (state)
 - b. Rookie of the Year (state)
 - c. Project of the Year (state)
 - d. Friend of Master Gardeners Organization and Individual (state)
 - f. Excellence in Education of the Year (state)
 - g. Mentor of the Year (state)
 - h. Joyce Mendenhall "Yes, I Can" Award of the Year (local award)

NOVEMBER

- 1. Sanctioned Project/Proposal Committee reviews sanctioned projects and makes recommendations to the Executive Committee as needed.
- 2. Awards Committee selects WCMG's state MG award winners and begins preparations for the annual WCMG Awards Program.
- 3. Incoming President reviews, appoints, and/or approves new Standing Committee and Sanctioned Project Chair(s.)

DECEMBER

- 1. Membership meeting and Winter Potluck Celebration.
- 2. State MG Online Training concludes.
- 3. All WCMG members and trainees record hours in Online Recording System by December 15th deadline.
- 4. Executive Committee holds its final meeting of the year.
