

EDUCATION HOURS DESCRIPTIONS

Washington County Master Gardeners

Every active WCMG member must acquire a minimum of 20 hours of continuing education each year. Travel time may not be counted. These hours can include:

#50 MG Meeting/Programs - attending our regular monthly meeting (*Note that each meeting counts as two hours of education.*)

#51 Program Preparation – researching and organizing information to present at a meeting or program.

#52 Gardening Workshops/Programs - attending any talk or program pertaining to gardening, such as those held at BGO, garden clubs, MG Leadership Training, etc.

#53 Garden Tours - visiting a botanical garden, lawn and garden show, Garden Gate Tour, etc.

#54 Reading Books/Magazines - reading blogs or any online garden-related research, reading garden catalogs and *The Garden Thyme* Newsletter (*You may enter a monthly total at the end of each month.*)

#56 Gardening TV Shows/Videos/Podcasts – watching television, YouTube, listening to podcasts, etc.

#57 State MG Conference – attending the State Master Gardener Conference held every spring somewhere in Arkansas.

#58 Regional/National/International MG Conference – attending the conference held every other year in different states.
