How to Participate:

There are two ways to submit your photo and entry form. Each month there will be a notification from Washington County Master Gardeners that will include the theme for the month and a link to an online entry form. (You will need to use the link that is sent for the current month, or your entry may not show up.)

An alternative to this process is to go to the WCMG website. Hover over “In the News” to find “Photo of the Month Competition.” On that page, scroll down until you see “Requirements” and beneath it “Photo Contest Form.” Clicking on that button will take you to the entry form. When finished, be sure to hit the “submit” button.

If you send the photo from your phone, you must send it "actual size," or the resolution will not be good enough to be accepted.

You will be notified via email when your photo and entry form are received. (Contact us at wcmgphotos@gmail.com if your entry hasn't been acknowledged within a couple of days.)
